
At a contract price of £360 and with applicable quality bonuses totalling £41.62, the value is £401.62 per tonne. See table below.


Bullish Market – OSR in High Demand

Your OSR is always going to be in high demand - especially over the next few years

Farmers growing OSR will capitalise on the opportunity presented by a market which has an annual home demand of 1.9 million tonnes, but nowhere near enough supply. The shortfall will continue until at least 2023, when in order to reach a supply and demand balance, 543,000 ha of OSR will need to be grown at a yield of 3.5t/ha (see graph right).

This high demand and shortage of supply will likely be bullish for OSR market prices.
