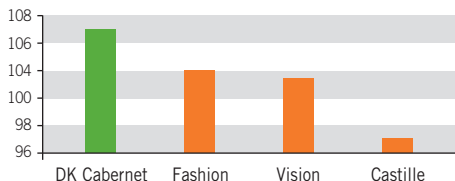


DK CABERNET – the consistent performer

DK Cabernet remains a firm favourite amongst growers thanks to its high oil content and exceptional seed yield. With a gross output of 107% it outperformed all other pure line varieties in 2010. It is an ideal variety for growers in the East and West region who are looking for reliable consistency.

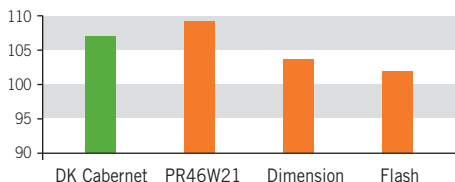


Gross output (%) - pure line varieties

Gross output (%) - overall

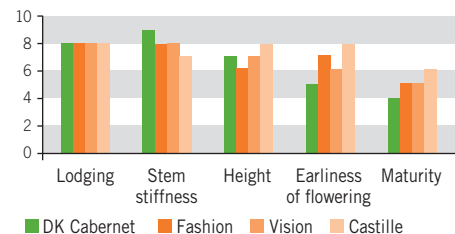

Agronomic characteristics

DK Cabernet has excellent agronomic characteristics. It offers a stiff stem and medium biomass and is late flowering with a late maturity rating to offer a spread of harvest dates.

Agronomic ratings

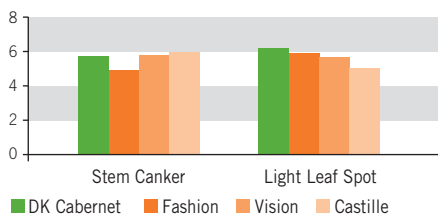

Disease resistance

DK Cabernet has exceptional disease resistance. It exhibits excellent resistance to Stem Canker which is increasingly important in tighter oilseed rape rotations. This, combined with its outstanding Light Leaf Spot resistance, makes DK Cabernet increasingly versatile in high disease pressure situations.
