Mentor has a 'Specific Recommendation' by AHDB for both East/West and North regions in 2017/18. It is resistant to common strains of clubroot, has a high gross output, is early maturing with a high oil content and yield, and good agronomic characteristics.

*Mentor is recommended for growing on land infected with common strains of clubroot. Mentor may, however, be infected by some strains and infections that have been reported in some fields.*

- ✓ Mentor has good seed yield combined with high oil content to give high gross output.
- ✓ Mentor has good resistance to Light leaf spot.
- ✓ Mentor has good stem stiffness and resistance to lodging and is of medium height.
- ✓ Mentor is a medium-early maturing variety.
