Mentor has a 'Specific Recommendation' by AHDB for both East/West and North regions in 2017/18. It is resistant to common strains of clubroot, has a high gross output, is early maturing with a high oil content and yield, and good agronomic characteristics.

Mentor is recommended for growing on land infected with common strains of clubroot. Mentor may, however, be infected by some strains and infections that have been reported in some fields.

- ✓ Mentor has good seed yield combined with high oil content to give high gross output.
- ✓ Mentor has good resistance to Light leaf spot.
- ✓ Mentor has good stem stiffness and resistance to lodging and is of medium height.
- ✓ Mentor is a medium-early maturing variety.
