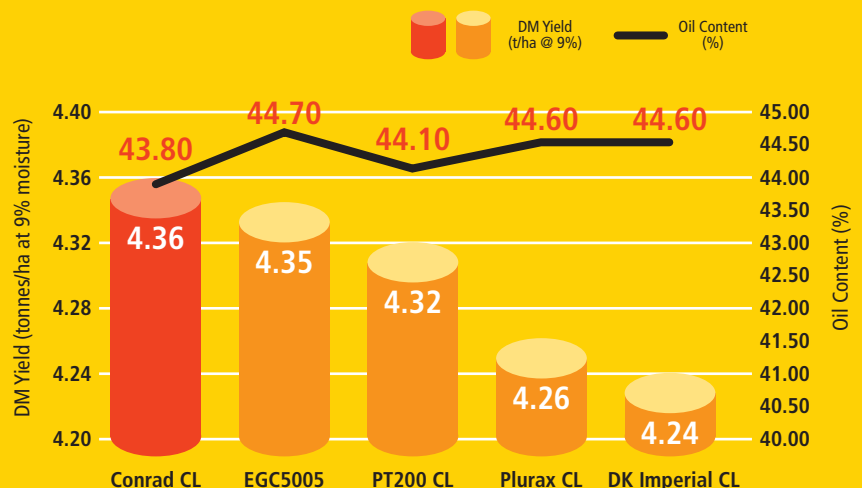

YIELD & OIL CONTENT

- Conrad CL has shown very high yield potential in NIABTAG Clearfield® trials that also suggest that it is competitive with non Clearfield varieties on the current AHDB Recommended List.
- Conrad CL is targeted at growers looking for high yield potential every year and in all conditions.
- The variety has high oil content enabling growers to maximise returns on their rapeseed crops. Excellent broad leaved weed and volunteer control from Clearfield varieties will potentially reduce the levels of erucic acid contamination, helping to avoid quality claims and rejections.
