DAILY MARKET REPORT

Aug Matif closed down €1.25. Crude oil jumped 10% on fears of a US military attack on Iran that would disrupt flows from the Middle East, which provides a 5th of the worlds oil output. President Trump cancelled a retaliatory strike as the action would not have been proportionate! Airlines are avoiding flying over the Straights of Hormuz. Soybeans were weaker following drier conditions anticipated in the coming days, just in time for the last planting day for soybeans to pass, however it may take too long for fields to dry out enough to get machinery working. Sterling easier today at €1.1179 (89.4p) as Hustings begin between Jeremy Hunt & Boris Johnson for the Tory leadership.

Market Drivers

Positive Market Drivers - EU OSR 19/20 production seen at 18.8mil/t. Veg oil usage to rise 3.2% (China/India), Reduction in Crude Oil production (OPEC). Negative Market Drivers - Global oilseed production seen at 600.5mil/t with greater soya production in Brazil & Nigeria. Chinese soy imports set to be 82mil/t in 2019/20. Ukrainian OSR crop seen up 70% to 1.54mil/t in 18. Argentinean 2019 Soy crop seen @ 56mil/t & Brazil @ 115mil/t. Global Soybean production seen @ 358mil/t.

Aug 19 Matif opened down €0.75. Matif slightly weaker following Soybeans lower as better weather in US increases hopes of drilling more soybeans. Warmer weather in the UK later this week will be welcome to all crops especially Pulses and OSR. With values near contract highs for New Crop, taking some cover for harvest movement will put a line in the sand. This Friday sees the USDA report on planted area and crop estimates, most analyst expect to see lower numbers which trigger more fund short covering, time will tell!!.
