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DAILY MARKET REPORT

Aug Matif closed up €1.00. US Corn plantings progressing at there slowest rate since 1980. Progress to remain slow over the next 10days amid rain and cool conditions. Soybean planting suffering as well. Canadian canola exports set to fall 8% due to Chinese trade woes. Chinese farmers are preparing to be hit by Armyworms which can devastate crops. Sterling is being hammered at €1.1322 (88.3p) as Prime Minister May's tenure looks even more uncertain as senior cabinet minister consider there positions. Donald Trump proposing to pay soybean growers \$2/bus based on acreage sowed this year to help make up for the lower prices due to his trade spat with China. Soy area set to climb to a record 90mil/ac due to less corn.

Market Drivers

Positive Market Drivers - EU OSR 19/20 production seen at 18.8mil/t. Veg oil usage to rise 3.2% (China/India), Reduction in Crude Oil production (OPEC).

Negative Market Drivers - Global oilseed production seen at 600.5mil/t with greater soya production in Brazil & Nigeria. Chinese soy imports set to be 82mil/t in 2019/20. Ukrainian OSR crop seen up 70% to 1.54mil/t in 18. Argentinean 2019 Soy crop seen @ 55mil/t & Brazil @ 115mil/t. Global Soybean production seen up 5% @ 352mil/t.

Aug 19 Matif opened up €0.25. With sterling weaker due to political upheaval and Brexit discussions this maybe an opportunity to price up Old Crop & Harvest tonnage if nothing has been done.
