### DAILY MARKET REPORT

#### MARKETS - DAILY COMMENTS & MARKET DRIVERS

On Thursday Nov-25 MATIF opened at €468.75 and traded between highs of €474.25 and lows of €467.00, before settling at €473.75, up

€4.00 on Wednesday's settlement.

- On the CBOT, Soybean futures increased by 6c to settle at \$9.74/bu. Soybean meal futures rose by \$3.50 settling at \$276.10/t for the Sep'25 expiry and oil fell 22c, settling at \$53.50/lb Price Impact Mixed
- On the Bursa Malaysia, Sep'25 crude palm oil fell 25RM to settle at 4,222RM. Price Impact Negative
- On the Dalian, Sep'25 soybeans rose 10CNY to 4,128CNY, soymeal fell by 7CNY to settle at 3,020CNY, and soy oil gained 66CNY and settled at 8,426CNY. Price Impact Mixed
- Nearby (Oct'25) Brent crude fell \$0.46 to settle at \$66.43/b. Price Impact Negative
- Yesterday, the Kremlin said Putin would meet with Trump in the coming days, raising expectations for a diplomatic end to the war in Ukraine. A White House official said this would happen as soon as next week. Price Impact Negative
- Benchmark European natural gas fell 30c to settle at 32.95/MWh (Sep'25). Price Impact Mixed
- Brazilian Ag. Ministry reports their total soybean exports were +9% year-on-year. Price Impact Negative
- Yesterday, rapeseed prices fell in the morning and early afternoon after aggressive selling from the crush locking in margins before moving into a positive territory in the afternoon. Price Impact Mixed
- With MATIF struggling to drop below €470 and harvests in the EU and UK being 75%+ done this may well mean an upticking in the latter part of the year. Price Impact Mixed






