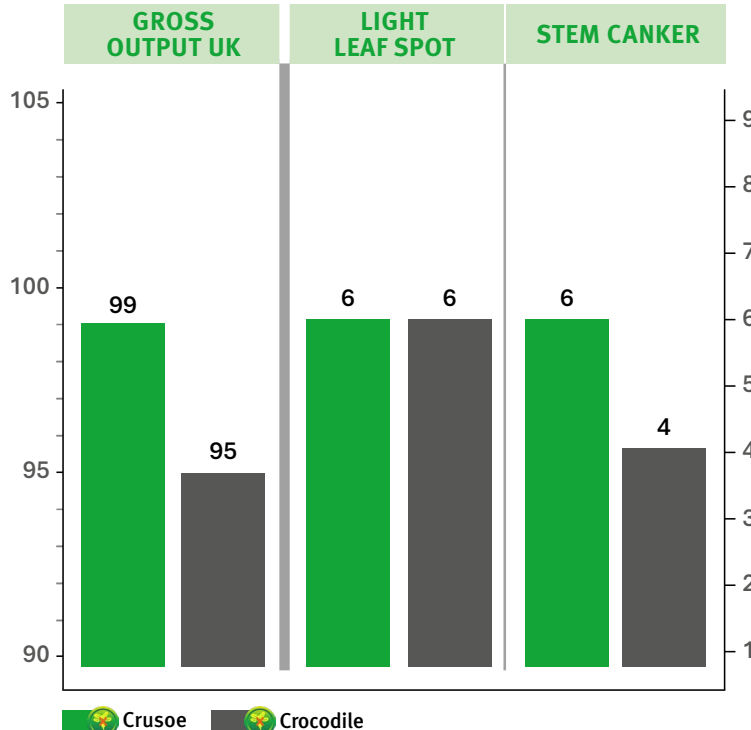
#### AGRONOMICS
